Post OP Medicines

1) Norco (Hydrocodone/APAP), OxyIR (Oxycodone), Percocet

(Oxycodone/APAP): Short acting pain pill, to be used as needed for pain.

2) Celebrex or Mobic: Anti-inflammatory, taken once a day for 1 month after surgery. Make sure you take this medication with food.

3) Senokot-S (Senna Plus) or Colace: Stool softener/laxative for constipation, Starting 2 days before surgery. Continue until you are no longer taking pain medicine.

4) Aspirin: 81mg tablet to be taken twice daily for 4 weeks after surgery to prevent blood clots. If you were on a blood thinner prior to surgery this will be resumed instead of aspirin.

5) Scopolamine patch: For nausea prevention. This patch will be applied at the hospital before your surgery.

6)An antibiotic will be given for one week after surgery to prevent infection and help wound healing.
